

# **Energy Saving Tips**

Caulk and weatherstrip doors and windows that leak air.

- · When home, turn down the heat to 68° F or as low as comfortable.
- $\cdot$  When you are asleep or away from home, turn thermostat back 7° to 10° for eight hours and save as much as 10% a year on your heating and cooling bills.
- · Consider changing to a programmable thermostat.
- Turn down the temperature of your hot water heater to 120°.
- · Have your oil-fired heating system serviced annually or your gas-fired heating system serviced every three years.
- · Clean or replace furnace filters every other month.
- · Keep the fireplace flue damper closed unless a fire is burning.
- · Check that warm-air registers, baseboard heaters and radiators are not blocked by furniture or drapes.
- During the winter heating season, close your curtains and shades at night; open them during the day.



### **Our Services**

#### **Home Energy Assistance - LIHEAP**

Helps pay a portion of eligible households' home heating bills during the winter season.

#### **HEARTWAP**

A year-round program that serves LIHEAP-eligible households with heating system repair, replacement and maintenance services.

#### **Weatherization Assistance Program**

A year-round program that serves LIHEAP-eligible households with air sealing, attic/sidewall insulation, weatherstripping, and weatherization related repairs.
