Program Benefits

- Weekly training stipend (20 hours per week during the classroom instruction phase)
- Compensated work-based learning (25 hours per week with participating energy employers)
- Attainment of industry certifications, including Lead Renovator (RRP), OSHA 10, and Confined Space certification
- Comprehensive case management, financial empowerment coaching, and one year of post-graduation support

Eligibility Requirements

- Ages 18 - 24
- Basic reading/math skills — checked with a quick, no-pressure assessment
- Reliable transportation required
- Ready to commit full-time for all 20 weeks, with intent to pursue full-time employment afterward
- A CORI/background check is required for participation. If you feel this may be a barrier for you, please reach out.



Especially encouraged to apply: low-income/out-of-school youth, justice-involved young people, bilingual/BIPOC applicants, young women, recent vocational HS grads or community college students without a defined path
